Unconfirmed Minutes of the Annual General Meeting, held at the Medical Society of London, 11 Chandos Street, Cavendish Square, London W1G 9EB at 6.00 p.m. on Tuesday 13 May 2014, with the President, Professor Prys Morgan in the chair and with thirty five members in attendance

1. Apologies for absence were received from nine members

2. Minutes of the Annual General meeting held on 8 May 2013
